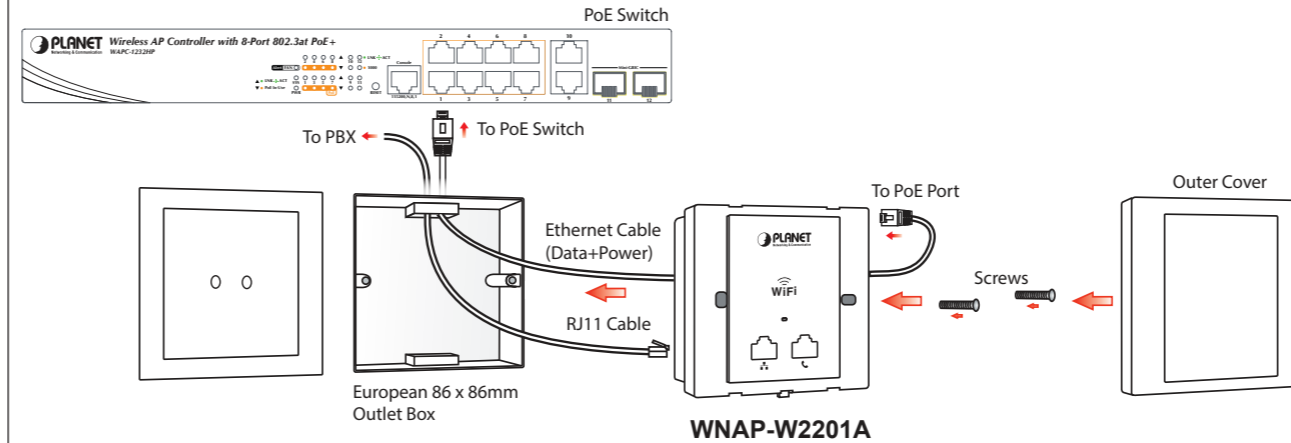

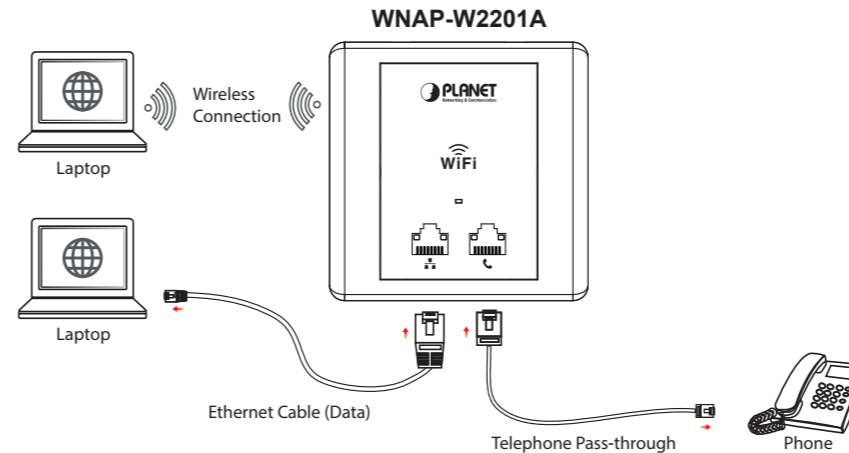
## 3. Hardware Installation

### Step 1: Follow the figure below to install the WNAP-W2201A

※ The Ethernet cable should not exceed 8cm in length from the end connecting to PoE port to the part that goes through the outlet box.



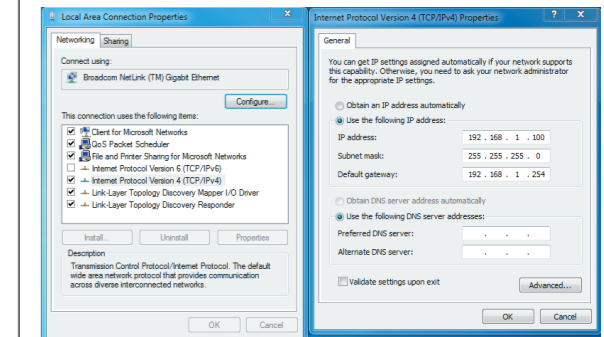
### Step 2: Follow the figure below to connect the network devices.



## 4. Wired Network Configuration (Windows 7)

A computer with wired Ethernet connection is required for the first-time configuration of the Wireless AP.

1. Click the **"Start"** button located at the lower-left corner of your computer.
2. Click **"Control Panel"**.
3. Double-click the **"Network and Sharing Center"** icon.
4. Click **"Change Adapter Settings"**.
5. Double-click **"Local Area Connection"**.
6. Select **"Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)"** and click **"Properties"**.
7. Select **"Use the following IP address"**, and then click the **"OK"** button twice to save the configuration. For example, as the default IP address of the WNAP-W2201A is 192.168.1.253 and the router is 192.168.1.254, you may choose from 192.168.1.1 to 192.168.1.252.



## 5. Enter into the Web Management

Default IP Address: **192.168.1.253**

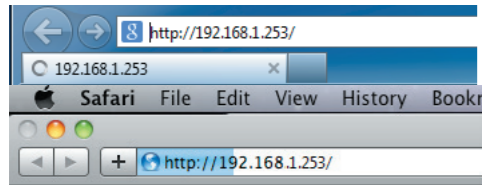
Default Username: **admin**

Default Password: **admin**

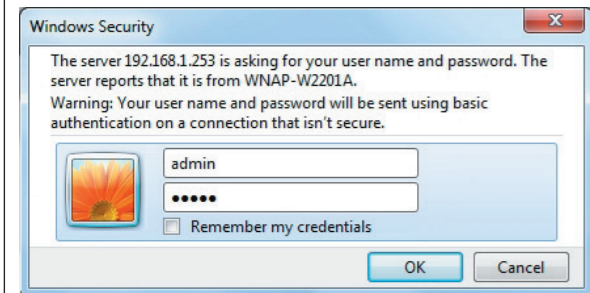
Default SSID: **PLANET\_XXXX** ("X" means the last 4 digits of the MAC address)

Default Wireless Encryption Type: **None**

**Step 1:** The Web management allows you to access and manage the Wireless AP easily. Launch the Web browser and enter the default IP address <http://192.168.1.253>



**Step 2:** When the login window pops up, please enter the User Name and Password. The default User Name and Password are both "admin". Then click the **OK** button to continue.



For security reasons, it is recommended to change the password at the first login and memorize it.

**Step 3:** After you enter into the Web User Interface, go to **Setup Wizard** to configure your wireless network. For security reasons, we strongly recommend you to configure the Encryption Method and Passphrase of your wireless network.



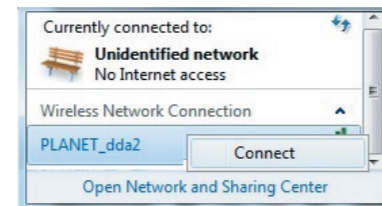
**Step 4:** Once the basic configuration of the WNPAP-W2201A is done, click the "**Finished**" button to make the change take effect.

## 6. Wireless Network Connection

**Step 1:** Right-click on the network icon displayed in the system tray.



**Step 2:** Highlight the wireless network (SSID) to connect and click the [Connect] button.



**Step 3:** Enter the encryption key of the WNPAP-W2201A if necessary.

You have already finished the configuration of the WNPAP-W2201A. Now you can use your iPhone, iPad, laptop or any other Wi-Fi device to connect with it wirelessly and start surfing the internet.

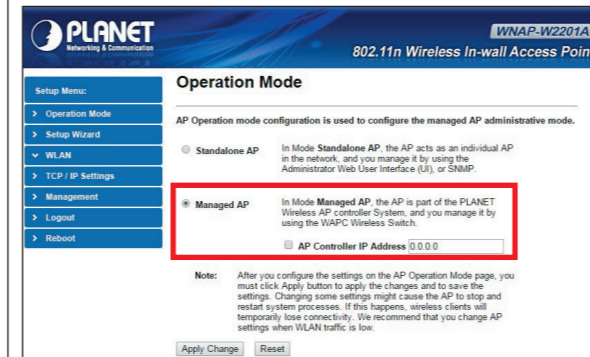
## 7. WNPAP-W2201A Installed with Wireless AP Controller

The WNPAP-W2201A can be managed from the computer via PLANET's Wireless AP Controller.

Follow the steps below to set up the WNPAP-W2201A from the operation mode to the managed AP mode.

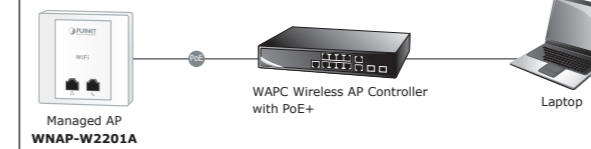
**Step 1:** Setting to "**Managed AP**" mode

1. Log in the WNPAP-W2201A's Web User Interface.
2. Click "**Operation Mode**".
3. Click "**Managed AP**".
4. After setting it up, press "**Apply Change**".

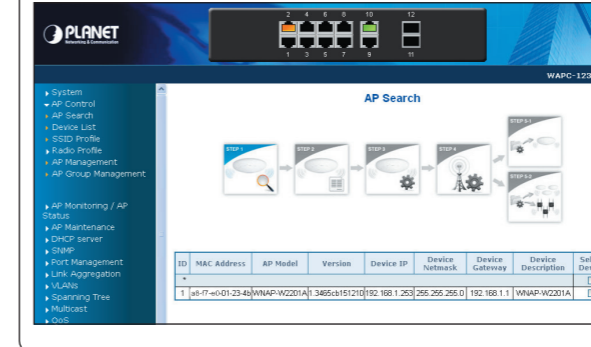


In this mode, multiple WNPAP-W2201As can connect directly or indirectly to the Wireless AP Controller for centralized management.

**Step 2:** Connect the WNPAP-W2201A, Wireless AP Controller and your computer to the same network.



**Step 3:** Launch the Web browser to log in to the WAPC Wireless AP Controller Web pages. Configure the Wireless setting for the WNPAP-W2201A under "AP Control".
